



Grand Fire and Grand Lake Fire are seeking a qualified engine boss and up to several additional crew members to bolster our jointly operated wildland program. These personnel will participate in training, local wildland response, mutual aid wildland responses, mitigation projects, and support national fire assignments. Crews may also help support other all-hazard incidents within the two fire districts and county.

Crew members can expect an exciting summer with opportunities for personal and professional growth, experiences on national fire assignments, and the chance to contribute to making Grand County safer through proactive fuels reduction. You'll be a part of a program with close ties to many partners including the Grand County Wildfire Council, shared facilities with a Colorado Division of Fire Prevention & Control module, and collaborative work with multiple federal agencies. The program has access to both type 3 and 6 engines for deployments.

The full season starts on April 28th and ends on October 25th (6 months / 1040 hours) The positions are seasonal, hourly, non-exempt positions, with PTO provided. Base pay is provided regardless of fire conditions for up to 40-hours per week minus holidays, with opportunities for overtime. Additional qualifications may justify additional compensation. Limited housing options may be available.
